Being one of the founder members of the school, it is indeed my proud privilege to share with you all our achievements and victories. Ten fanatic years have rolled by and each year has added to the treasure of our experiences that we carry within us.

DPS Society is recognized throughout the academic world, for its progressive approach and commitment to excellence. Keeping up to the tradition, I feel extremely ostentatious to announce the excellent academic result of class X and XII.

- ❖ To begin with class XIIth result- The academic result of class XIIth has brought National fame and glory to the school with Mihir Jain(in Political Science and Abhijeet Jain (in Computer Science),scoring 99% , being declared as Regional Toppers. Followed by Shailja Tiwari scoring 95.6% from Biology stream and Mihir Jain ,scoring 95.6% from commerce stream, being declared as City Toppers.

Out of 96 enrolled students, 7 students scored more than 90% and 35 students scored above 75%.

- ❖ In prestigious Competitive exams also our students could figure themselves. 4 students cracked NEET and achieved admirable ranking countrywide.

The NEET Qualifiers are- Vidushi Chaturvedi- Raipur Institute of Medical Science , Priyansha Singh- Chirayu Medical College Bhopal, Vanshika Sharma JNSS, University, Hyderabad, & Akash Shrivastava- Pune Medical College.

Not only this, 9 students of our school were able to clear JEE mains and qualify for JEE Advance. The students qualifying were Piyush Parwani, Anjali Thakur, Abhijeet Jain, Divyansh Sahu, Satyam Mamar, Anudesh Kumar, Akshat Agrawal, Nayan Agrawal, Shivam Saraf, and Ketan Jain.

- ❖ Followed by resounding success of class XII students ,we have 20 students of class X out of 114, who have shown their star performances this year. The No. of Students scoring A1 Grade in English are 45, Hindi 47, Maths 23, Science 30, and Social Science 36.
- ❖ I extend hearty congratulations to our proud parents.
- ❖ In order to enable students select career option of their choice the school organized career counseling sessions by renowned experts thrice in this year .
- ❖ It gives me immense pleasure to announce that, this year, the school joined hands with the renowned Rotary Club of Jabalpur to host two students under the “**YOUTH EXCHANGE PROGRAMME**” from Venezuela – Juan Diego and Paula Sanchez who would be serving as ambassador for their country, benefitting through immersion in the Indian culture.
- ❖ With a vision to cultivate 1 million children as innovators, NITI AYOOG ,the think tank of GOI, New Delhi, has initiated to establish **Atal Tinkering Lab**,in 500 schools, across the country, under ATAL INNOVATION MISSION. We take pride to inform you that out of more than 13000 schools, so far, only 257 schools have been selected for it and DPS MANDLA Road is one among them, qualifying for receiving the grant of Rs. 20lakhs by NITI AYOOG, for its establishment in the school.
- ❖ Our school aims at discovering innovating and invigorating thoughts so that the young minds are able to face the challenges of the world. To provide a good exposure, the school endeavoured to take projects for the students, ONCE AGAIN from **British Council London**, being a recipient of ISA award.
- ❖ The Institution is proud to announce that 8 Scout and Guide students from DPS Mandla Road– qualified for the **Governor’s Award** this year.
- ❖ The School was also awarded with ‘GREEN SCHOOL CERTIFICATE’ by the Centre for Science and Environment for its best Infrastructure based on the highest rating under the Green School’s Programme.
- ❖ Apart from this, the students actively participated in various **Olympiads**. Under IEO, 2 students Pravah Thakre and Shivansh Singh Parihar got 1st International ranking and Nayan Kumar got International ranking 2nd along with Gold Medal.Our students have also secured 22 Medal of Excellence, 14 Gold Medals, 11Silver Medals and 12 Bronze Medals awarded by Science Olympiad Foundation, New Delhi. In the session 2015-16, number of students participated in National Cyber Olympiad and Maths Oympiad organised by SOF. 7 students- Aniket Singh, Soumya Dwivedi, Ayush Balyan, Bidipta

Samanta, Abhinav Singh, Aditya Vij and Ishan Dubey qualified for the second level exam and received thousand rupees scholarship along with certificate of merit. Aniket Singh and Abhinav Singh also cleared International Maths Olympiad 2nd level.

- ❖ SOF in association with British Council awarded the prestigious 5th Scholarship of Excellence in English(S.E.E)2015-16 to Munish Gupta, with a cash prize of Rs. 5000 and a merit certificate. The school Bagged this award for the third consecutive year
- ❖ Under **NSTSE**, students added feathers to our cap. 5 students of class-1 secured position in National top 100 performers. 14 students qualified for the second level of examinations and Shailja Tiwari of Class XII secured IIIrd position in the State level. Naivedhya Bhatia of class-1, secured 1st position, national ranking and was felicitated in Hyderabad.
